Caregiver Training Services (CTS)

- CTS is a new Medicare Part B benefit to reimburse eligible providers for providing care giver training services without the patient being present.
- A caregiver is defined as a family member, friend, neighbor, or other person with a significant relationship with the patient and is unpaid.
- CTS cannot be provided by telehealth.
 - Service must be rendered in a clinic setting with the provider present.

CTS Eligible Providers

- Physicians
- Non-Physician Practitioners and Therapists
 - Nurse Practitioners
 - Physician Assistants
 - Clinical Psychologists, MFTs, & MHCs
 - Clinical Social Workers
 - Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists, and Speech-Language Pathologists









Time-Based Billing (Individual & Group)

- Billing is based on the number of patients being represented during the training:
- Multiple family members receiving training for the same beneficiary is individual training.
- Multiple family members representing two (2) or more beneficiaries is group training.

CTS Categories

- Behavior Management/Modification Training
 - Training for patients with mental or physical health diagnosis
- Training to facilitate functional performance
 - Training regarding activities of daily living, IADLs, transfers, mobility, communication, swallowing, feeding, problem solving, safety practices, position changes, turning in bed, pressure sore prevention, placement of incontinence supplies.









CTS: Group Behavior Management/Modification Training

HCPCS	Descriptor	Non-Facility Rate	Facility Rate
96202	Mlt fam grp bhv training. 1 st 60 min	\$23.63	\$25.82
96203	Mlt fam grp bhv training. Each additional 15 min	\$5.66	\$6.18

Behavior Management/Modification Training can only be provided as a group. There is no individual behavior management/modification training code.









CTS: Training to Improve Functional Performance

HCPCS	Descriptor	Non-Facility Rate	Facility Rate
97550	Indv. Caregiver training 1 st 30 min.	\$52.93	\$45.27
97551	Indv. Caregiver training. Ea. additional 15 min.	\$26.30	\$24.30

- 1. Training to improve ADLs and IADLs to improve functional performance.
- 2. These codes are for individual training only. The individual refers to the number of beneficiaries not the number of caregivers.
- 3. 2 or more caregivers for a single beneficiary is individual training not group.

Rate Changes due to PFS Conversion Factor Adjustment

- March 9, 2024 December 31, 2024 the fee schedule has been updated.
- The updated fee schedule reflects requirements by new legislation that revises the physician fee schedule conversion factor. This results in increased payment rates.
